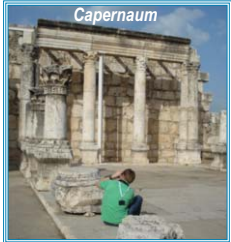
Catholic Pilgrimage 2012

Day 1 and 2 - USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy dinner before you rest.

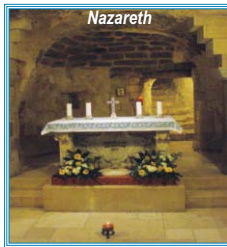
Day 3 - The Galilee

Travel to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue, which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4: 13, 23). With Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. At Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar, you'll learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Travel to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). Celebrate Mass in the Church of the Beatitudes. At Tabgha, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves (Luke 9:10-17). You'll also visit the Chapel of the Primacy where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). At the River Jordan you can remember your baptism in the Yardenit Baptismal Site.

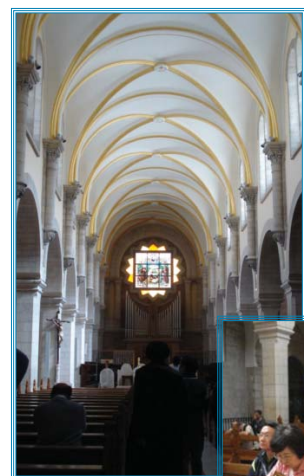


Day 4 - Nazareth and Caesarea

Visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23). Celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the Annunciation. Visit the House of the Holy Family, St. Joseph's Workshop, and St. Joseph's Church (Luke 2:41-52; Matt 2:19-23). Visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for Trial.



Day 5 - Jericho, Qumran and Bethlehem



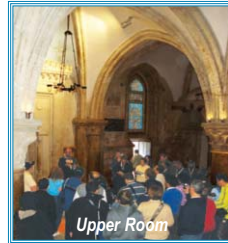
St. Catherine Church in Bethlehem



Travel to Jericho and visit the ruins of the ancient city, which was conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6: 1, 2, 20). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4: 1-11). Even today, the road from Jericho to Jerusalem twists for miles as it climbs from below sea level into the Judean mountains. Jesus traveled the nearby Roman road, the setting of His parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 30-36). Travel to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. In Bethlehem, you'll visit the cave revered as the place where Jesus was born (Matt. 1: 18 - 25; Luke 2: 1- 7). Celebrate Mass in St. Catherine Church. Nearby you'll view Shepherds' Field where the Good News was first heard.

Day 6 - Jerusalem

Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9 - 12). Visit the Church of the Pater Noster. Celebrate Mass in the Garden of Gethsemane as Jesus prayed (Matt.26: 36 - 44). Visit the Tomb of the Virgin Mary. On Mount Zion visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas where Jesus was imprisoned for a night (Matt. 26: 57 - 65). Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12- 26). Finally conclude your day at the Church of the Dormition of Mary.

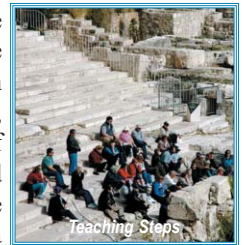


Day 7 - Masada and Dead Sea Tour

Celebrate Mass this morning in Jerusalem before your journey to the Dead Sea. Explore Masada, Herod's mountaintop fortress which became the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Time permitting, you'll stop briefly at the Shores of the Dead Sea for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters.

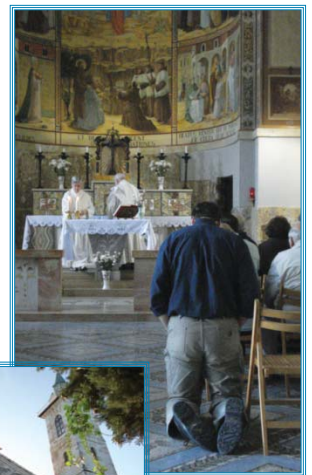
Day 8 - Jerusalem and the Old City

Visit the Southern Wall Excavations of the Temple including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. Walk the Cardo, the ancient main street of the Old City once lined with shops, now partially restored. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1 - 11). Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross", and celebrate Mass of the Resurrection at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.



Day 9 - Ein Karem, Emmaus and Mt. Tabor

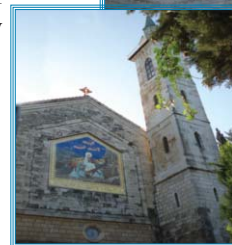
Travel to Ein Karem where Mary visited with Elizabeth prior to our Lord's birth and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation. Visit the Church of St. John, the birthplace of John the Baptist. Time permitting, you will visit Yad Vashem. Continue to Emmaus, the traditional site of Jesus appearance. Ascend Mount Tabor where Jesus was transfigured before Saints Peter, James and John (Matt 17:2).

Day 10 - Return to USA

Return home with memories of the people and places of the Holy Land!



Cairo and the Route of the Exodus

5-day* extension \$906

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Travel ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai Desert** to the base of **Mount Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Continue to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** to see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Admire ancient treasures, including King Tut's, at the **Egyptian Museum**. Explore the famous **Citadel of Old Cairo** and **Coptic Church**. **Sail the Nile River aboard an authentic Egyptian Felucca**.

Day 14 and 15 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Egypt and Luxor

7-day* extension \$1416

Day 10 - 11 Your Itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. In the early evening, board the overnight train to **Luxor** or fly to **Luxor for an additional \$125** (includes dinner and overnight in Cairo plus breakfast and morning flight to Luxor).

Day 13 & 14 (Lunches included on these days.) Cross the Nile River to visit the **Valley of Kings and Queens**. After overnight in Luxor, visit the magnificent **Karnak Temple** and the **Luxor Temple**. **Fly to Cairo**.

Day 15 Admire ancient treasures, including King Tut's, at the **Egyptian Museum**.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Nile Cruise

7-day* extension \$1576

Day 10 - 11 Your itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 This morning you will enjoy a half day tour of **Cairo**, including the **Egyptian Museum** where you will see **King Tut's Treasures**, the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. This afternoon you will fly to Aswan where you will board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 Visit the **High Dam of Aswan** and the **Granite Quarry** where you can see the **Unfinished Obelisk**. Visit the **Temple of Philae** before sailing to the beautiful **Temple of Kom Ombo**. After your visit to the temple shared by two gods, your cruise continues along the Nile.

Day 14 Visit the **Temple of Horus in Edfu**. Continue via the **Nile Lock** and sail to **Luxor**.

Day 15 Disembark and cross to the Western Bank where you will visit the **Necropolis of Thebes**, the **Valley of the Kings and Queens**, the **Temple of Hatshepsut** and the **Colossi of Memnon**. On the East Bank, you'll visit the amazing **Temples of Luxor and Karnak**. Fly back to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Jordan and Petra

3-day extension \$866

Day 10 In the morning, you will cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. View the "promised land" as Moses did from the summit of **Mt. Nebo**. Nearby **Madaba** is home to a beautiful 6th century mosaic of Jerusalem. Visit Philadelphia, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis, and now **Amman**.

Day 11 Early in the morning you'll journey to the famous rock city of **Petra**, literally cut into the cliff sides. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 Explore the ruins of **Jerash**, Jordan's best-preserved Greco-Roman town. Depart the Holy Land this evening.

Day 13 Arrive in the USA.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While EOT will try to match roommates, EOT cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$548 during the basic week; \$298 for Cairo; \$398 for Luxor; \$398 for Nile Cruise; \$198 for Jordan.

AIRLINE ROUTES and TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, EOT does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once "printed", airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class on IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together on entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. EOT is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. ITINERARY CHANGES:

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure. Due to airline schedules, some participants may receive one or two extra leisure days at a nominal per day charge and some extensions may not be available on all departure dates.
