



FAMILY FORMATION

Family Formation forms adults *and* children to be faithful disciples of Jesus Christ.

Since parents are the first teachers of the faith to their children, Family Formation empowers parents to share the Good News and the beauty of the Catholic Faith at home. Through weekly Home Lessons and monthly Family Formation Nights at church, Family Formation strives to build strong families: families that are rooted in faith and in the joy and love of God.

Family Formation Format:

Weekly Home Lessons

(for grades 1st-6th)

Help you teach and live the Faith at home as a family.

Monthly Family Formation Nights

Held every first (sometimes second) Wednesday of the month Oct.–May.

Parents and children attend adult formation.

First Communion Preparation

Children receive 2 years of preparation for First Communion.

In their second year (or 2nd grade year) of Family Formation, parents receive Sacrament Workbooks with weekly Home Lessons for First Reconciliation and First Communion preparation.

Children attend First Communion Classes at the monthly Family Formation Night

Weekly Confirmation Preparation

Confirmation Preparation take place over a 2-year period (typically in 7th and 8th grade)
